# **Praying for Pastors**

"He will stand and shepherd His flock in the strength of the LORD...
and they will live securely." Micab 5:4

"The biblical fact is that there are no successful churches. There are instead, communities of sinners, gathered before God week after week in towns and villages all over the world. The Holy Spirit gathers them and does his work in them. In these communities of sinners, one of the sinners is called pastor and given a designated responsibility... to keep the community attentive to God." (Eugene Petersen)

"We are Christians for our own sake. We are leaders for your sake. The fact that we are Christians should serve our own advantage. The fact that we are leaders should serve only yours." (Saint Augustine)

"When this simple truth is forgotten, more attention is paid to pastor's position in the church than to his position in Christ. The duties of ministry begin to outrun the devotion of the heart, and commitment to goals displaces communion with God. How easily a work for God can become a substitute for a walk with God. How unintentionally does the flock's need for the pastor's attention, displace the Father's need for the pastor to be attentive to Him? How imperceptibly does the organic and corporate Body of Christ become an organized corporation? How unconsciously are ministering pastors expected to become mediating priests? How subtly does the call to 'lead' the flock become the temptation to 'lord' it over them?"

"There are many influences in the church and in the world that seek to shape pastors into their own image by insisting that they pour their lives into forms that suit the desires of man rather than satisfy the demands of God; that sentence them to human subservience rather than free them for divine service; that expect them to revere the structures formulated by men more than the Scriptures inspired by the Holy Spirit." (Stuart McAlpine)

## **ASK For:**

- For the recovery of the preaching of Christ crucified and risen, for this will guard the heart of the pastor who speaks it, and the hearts of the sheep in the pastures who hear it.

- Pastors will identify with the sorrow of the lost and be involved restoratively in their recovery; that they will be used to minister healing to all who return; that pastoral oversight will have more to do with restoration of souls than the reorganization of structures...1 Peter 2:24-25

- Give thanks to God for His faithful shepherds who are
