North Korea continued . . .

There is an elite class that consists of Kim Jung II, government staff, the military, police, and a small percentage of the population. They are well fed, clothed and housed. The rest of the population of North Korea lives in abject poverty in a country that has become a huge prison camp.

The conditions there are becoming even worse. An Open Doors' press release quotes Church leaders as saying, "The country has called for '100 days of combat." (This means that practically everyone has to work for the state. Any person found on the street without a valid reason is sent to a labor camp.) "The people don't have much opportunity to keep themselves alive. In Hwangae province it's normal **again** to see dead children in the street."

The Christians of North Korea ask for your fervent prayers.

The persecution of Christians varies in method and intensity from country to country. In China, there is now less harshness. However, the battle goes on.

The following letter excerpts are from an unusually large "underground Church."

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

On October 30th 2009, Shouwang Church left the Huajie Plaza We left due to the continual pressure from the authorities that the owners of the rooms the church rented were coming under. For the love of Christ, the church did not want the landlord to shoulder the pressure that the church should shoulder. . . . our brothers and sisters braved the wind and snow attending Sunday worship at the east gate of the Haidian Park on the first of November.

In his sermon Pastor Tianming quoted Hebrews 11:23–31. God led Moses and the Israelites out of Egypt by cultivating faith in their lives, and they made the choice by faith.

... we ask our Christian family to pray earnestly to our God with us... we look forward to God's special protection ... "the pillar of cloud by day, the pillar of fire by night."

This is a road our generation has never walked. But we do believe it is a road the Lord has walked. As long as we are willing to offer ourselves to God and to pay all the cost following in His footsteps, the Lord will definitely lead us to victory in Him.
