"The Spirit of God has made me, and the breath of the Almighty gives me life."

China is the most populous nation with 1.3 billion people. In 1979, the communist government began their one-child policy to limit population growth. It is now estimated that the population has been reduced by 300 million. — The ancient bias toward male children, to continue lineage and protection in old age, has resulted in a disdain for female infants—leading to their abortion, neglect, abandonment, and even infanticide. The gender imbalance is now 120 males to 100 females. More than 24 million Chinese men could find themselves without wives by 2020, cites the Chinese Academy of Social Sciences.

The Church in China is vast, some say as much as 6% of the population. Though a large portion of the church is underground or persecuted, they are thriving. (1 Corinthians 1:18–31) A new ministry to the persecuted church is calling them to go to other persecuted nations. They, who have nothing, are giving and going to others with the message of the cross, the power of God.

ASKing for Him in our lack:
