AFGHANISTAN

Afghanistan is the second most corrupt country in the world, according to the Corruption Perceptions Index. The Taliban, overthrown in 2001 after 30 years of civil war, is resurging. — Gender-based injustice, poverty, social stigmas, and war increase the risks to mothers and children. Every half hour, two Afghan women and fourteen children die from health issues. Afghanistan has the highest infant mortality rate in the world, making it the most dangerous place for a child to be born. **But God**... During the civil war millions were displaced to neighboring countries, many returned home with faith in Jesus! Because it is normal to talk about God in Afghanistan, the underground Church is advancing the kingdom of God.

ASKing Points for Afghanistan:

- Prince of Peace to rule in the nation. "For a child will be born to us, a son will be given to us; And the government will rest on His shoulders; And His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace." Isaiah 9:6
- Salvation. The nation is 98% Islamic. The violent abuse against women and children is against the very nature of God. "Let it be known to all of you... there is salvation in no one else; for there is no other name under heaven that has been given among men by which we must be saved." Acts 4:10–12 "For He rescued us from the domain of darkness, and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son." Colossians 1:13
- Just leaders. "May he judge Your people with righteousness; Your afflicted with justice. . . . He will

have compassion on the poor and needy . . . He will rescue their life from oppression and violence; their blood will be precious in his sight." Psalm 72:2, 13, 14

- Favor for those serving/ministering. "Open your mouth for . . . the rights of all the unfortunate . . . defend the rights of the afflicted and needy." Proverbs 31:8–9
- Afghan men to tenderly love their wives. That they will receive the love of Christ and give it. "Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her . . . Our Capital Cities continued . . .

In Jonah 3, we see an amazing move of God begin amongst the people and go to the palace. What a great precedence for prayer today! Just as both people and palace are influenced by the principalities that gather in capital cities, so they can be transformed by the presence of God.

ASK for your nation's capital city:

- ASK for the people, for the palace. "First of all, then, I urge that entreaties and prayers, petitions and thanksgivings, be made on behalf of all men, for kings and all who are in authority, so that we may lead a tranquil and quiet life in all godliness and dignity. This is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth." 1 Timothy 2:1–4
- ASK for the Church. "Is this not the fast which I choose, To loosen the bonds of wickedness, To undo the bands of the yoke, And to let the oppressed go free And break every yoke? Is it not to divide your bread with the hungry And bring the homeless poor into the house; When you see the naked, to cover him; And not to hide yourself from your own flesh? Then your light will break out like the dawn, And your recovery will speedily spring forth; And your righteousness will go before you; The glory of the LORD will be your rear guard. Then you will call, and the LORD will answer; You will cry, and He will say, 'Here I am.' If you remove the yoke from your midst, The pointing of the finger and speaking wickedness, And if you give yourself to the hungry And satisfy the desire of the afflicted, Then your light will rise in darkness And your gloom will become like midday." Isaiah 58:6–10 (ASK also: Isaiah 61:1–11; Romans 8:29–39; 2 Corinthians 5:14–20.) ▶
