The civil war that raged in Sudan killing over 2 million of its citizens finally came to an end on July 9, 2011 and South Sudan became the newest nation in the world. The black Africans of South Sudan who are mainly Christians and compose the largest ethnicity of that region have been seeking peace. The mostly Muslim Arabic north under the direction of President Omar al-Bashir is targeting the Christians of South Sudan with bombs that have destroyed most of the area where the Nuba mountain people live. 800,000 people are slowly being annihilated, victims of ethnic cleansing. According to President Bashir, their only crime is that they are black and refuse to submit to his radical Islamic government. Mr. Bashir has been indicted by the International Criminal Court for war crimes related to this genocide. In spite of that, for the last 9 months the world has ignored this humanitarian crisis. The relentless bombing destroyed crops and 500 churches, and caused the population to flee their homes. to the mountains. They are living in caves for protection or in refugee camps that humanitarian groups have set up. They are resorting to eating leaves from thorn bushes, roots, tree bark and bugs in the mountains where there is little other food. With the rainy season approaching Samaritan's Purse and other aid agencies will not be able to reach these suffering people over the muddy roads. Airlifts would be the only recourse and the cargo planes are no match for the Mig fighter jets and Antonov bombers of the north.
