Page 2 - Community

God is willing and ready to bring a revelation of His Son to every campus in every nation. All we need is the will to pray and intentionally engage with Him. Have you allowed God to stretch the borders of your prayer-life with His desire for His Son to be known, loved, and obeyed throughout the world of academia?

A major stronghold that prevents people from praying and believing for college and university campuses, is the towering stronghold of unbelief, expressed through the seductive eloquence of intellectualism, and rationalism. Refuse to be intimidated. Evil is never ultimate. *Nothing or no one*, can thwart God's purposes. There is a cry arising in the hearts of God's people for the hardest, darkest places. Join that cry.

There is one condition to demolishing strongholds, and it's about our *own* obedience being fulfilled. Ask the Holy Spirit to clearly point out places of unfulfilled obedience in your own life, then, joyfully obey, and see God demolish barriers erected against a knowledge of Jesus through your intercession and intervention.

Ways to Pray

- Ask God today to raise up Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego like students who will not bow, bend or burn, in declaring their allegiance to God. <u>Daniel 3:14</u>-20
- 2. Ask God today to give students who know Him power to declare His name, and not be ashamed of the gospel because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes. Romans 1:15–17
- 3. Ask God to raise up student leaders that are filled with boldness, creativity, winsomeness and wisdom to present Christ. Daniel 1:17
- 4. Ask God for a sustained move of the Holy Spirit on your campus that brings many to Jesus and creates century long holy reverberations throughout culture, as in Wesley's day. (If you are not a student, consider adopting a campus to pray for, making it "your campus.")
- 5. Bless those called to write and lecture that know God. Ask for a keen anointing to come upon them, and that they would have many opened doors.
- Bless ministries that target campus outreach. Explore their websites. Tell them you're praying.
